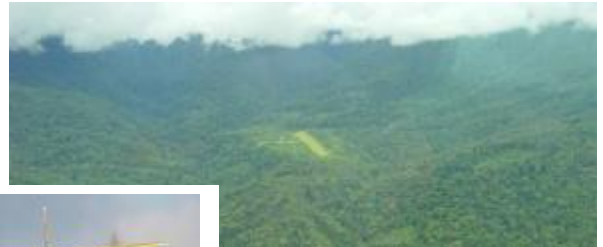

The Kodiak has flown 35 hours and is flying nearly every day with stellar performance leading to FAA Certification. God has guided, protected and blessed us in this difficult task with frugal resources and a dedicated *team*. He directed us to trust Him in a very unusual *strategy*. A Charitable Trust owns the Quest Company with no human owners. The Trustees serve without compensation and they help with funding. We have no investors, no venture capital and no commercial debt.
