The Kodiak is flying with stellar performance! I flew it for the first time in February and have never flown a plane with so much power and performance and yet so stable at all air speeds.

Kelly Mahon flew to Boise to show the Kodiak to the US Game and Wildlife department who may want several. Kelly said “After the recent good report from their pilot who saw the Kodiak in Sandpoint, they were ready for their decision makers to see it. They love the plane and had few concerns, so I think we will be able to put something together with them.”

Kelly reports, “new fairings added 13 kts. Even with headwinds the Kodiak made quick work of the trip in 1:40 from start to shut down. I cruised at 187 kts true airspeed, burning 40-42 GPH!!!”

Our faithful supporting *team*-mates have added commitment to their faith, knowing that their labor is not in vain in the Lord. Eagerly and joyfully they have joined the Quest leadership team (pictured below) and our Quest staff as we attempt the impossible for God, in this dynamic adventure. *-It is exciting to know we work for God.*



Commercial sales begin in May and hopefully FAA certification by the end of 2005 and production starts in 10 months! We need the funding to be over by then and the project to become self-funding by 2007.
