Kodiak Flight #100 on April 6 was significant in many ways. Kelly Mahon showed Franklin what the Kodiak could do and reports, “Franklin fell in love with the Kodiak before we even pushed it out of the hangar. The first take-off was rather benign at 600 ft and he could not get over the performance. When we came back, I did a 200 ft take-off with 3 of us on board and 290 gallons of fuel -he could not find words to express his emotions. When we opened the door his first words were, I want one!”

Franklin has visited Quest twice and now flew the Kodiak through stalls and slow-flight maneuvers. He is an avid pilot and flies his own **Samaritan's Purse** aircraft. They operate several aircraft around the world in missionary and humanitarian work. After landing Franklin admitted, “I am so sorry I just bought another Cessna Caravan for our work because I want two of these.”

The Quest Manufacturing Facility will be finished by July



Our existing R&D facility is 17,000 sq ft with the attached 10,000 sq ft two-story office and engineering block. This new manufacturing structure will add an additional 57,000 sq ft. On January 28 the Quest Board made the unanimous and courageous step of faith to approve this building expansion and ordered the needed production machinery.

§ Kodiak flies to Alaska in May to begin commercial sales.
§ FAA Certification expected by year-end or early 2006.
§ Production should begin early 2006.

§ To accomplish this we must expand our building - \$1.9m.
§ We also must buy production quality machinery - \$1.1m.
§ Since we have no income or commercial credit, we must pay COD for the building and equipment this summer.

§ \$8,000,000 should complete and totally fund the project.

§ Our 2005 budget is \$7,343,000.

§ We still need \$4,000,000 in 2005.

§ We must raise most of this by mid-summer.

§ Our cooperating mission organizations are also helping by raising funds to match your gifts, so your gifts get doubled!
