**Dear Praying and Supporting Friends,**

**Solomon said, “there is a time for everything...”**

**Exciting things are happening in our Quest Project that could finish the funding phase this year!**

It is time to bring the donor funding phase of this great project to an end! To do that we must raise \$3,000,000 this summer to pay for the Quest manufacturing facility and the production machinery needed to move the project from our current R&D phase into full commercial production as FAA approvals are obtained -hopefully early in 2006. We must become self-funding and profitable to enable us to build and deliver the 11 commercial and 15 mission Kodiaks already on order.

You are part of all this with your faithfully prayers and giving to make this remarkable vision a reality. *We greatly honor and thank you for that!!* I now have a Video-CD (e-mail me if you want one) to show you what we have accomplished together for God and to ask you for yet another significant *-and perhaps your last sacrificial gift to make all this happen!*

Let me explain our *urgent need* and then the extraordinary good news will follow. Since we have no income or ability to secure credit or commercial loans, we had to commit to paying cash for our \$1.8m building expansion and the \$1.2m machinery we must have to build Kodiaks. These \$3,000,000 payments come due in late July. *-That’s the bad news...*

*Now the good news;* -we have a good start on the funding to complete the FAA Certification. As this gets covered, it leaves this remaining \$3,000,000 as our primary fixed asset capital expenditure. As you know, we give all donated funding to our participating mission organizations as a matching grant and as the first half of their deposits on their “at-cost” future Kodiaks. They return this funding to us immediately and commit to matching it. *More good news* is that we had an outstanding reception of the Kodiak into the commercial market at our May 14-15 Anchorage sales debut.

This project is unlike any I have ever worked on before in that the funding phase has an end -possibly yet this year!! Our plan is to become self-funding to supply aircraft and raise funds through commercial profits to help many mission efforts worldwide. I ask you to consider this last opportunity to give “*over-and-above*” during this crucial time of need, as your leveraged investment in the future of worldwide missions through this Quest endeavor.
