The Kodiak has nearly 200 hours of flight testing and still amazes us on nearly every flight. The official performance figures will not be out until the flight test program is complete later this fall, but suffice it to say they are impressive and meeting our earlier predictions.

With 19 inches of prop to ground clearance, big tires and rugged landing gear, we now know the Kodiak can handle jungle airstrips in Congo as well as Alaska river sandbars.
