Our last newsletter left you hanging with critical Ultimate Loads testing about to start. Our FAA inspector was called for jury duty but has returned and the many Ultimate Load tests are proceeding well and should be completed by the end of March.



With this critical testing proceeding well, we have started to build the first production Kodiak.

Several major tests remain including 200-300 in-flight spin tests and many FAA reports. Please pray that all this can be accomplished by summer.



The latest Garmin G1000 “glass-cockpit” technology is now installed in the Kodiak. It provides engine and flight instrumentation along with radio communications and GPS world-wide flight route mapping. It is lighter, cheaper and more reliable than the old round gauges and establishes our Kodiak’s “rugged-refinement for the 21st century” identity.

This Quest project is *world-wide* and *mission-wide* and by its very nature will target the *poorest* and *most needy* people on earth who have the least access to the Gospel. It is to these “*ends of the earth*” people that Christ specifically directed His Matthew 28 Mandate to us. This Quest project will have a profound impact and ability to expedite Christ’s Greatest Command. It is exciting to be linked with you in reaching these remaining unreached!

Much of our engineering effort is behind the scenes so it is great to see another milestone such as the Cargo Pod actually on the Kodiak and flying well. We should have the floats for landing on water by spring.

We invite you to a very special **Open House on April 13th** from 9:30-2:30pm. Most of our missionary partners will be with us as well. By then the assembly line should be up and running with MUCH to see. **Please RSVP.**

We have seen phenomenal progress this past year with successful prototype flying, completion of our 84,000 sq. ft. manufacturing facility, state-of-the-art production machinery installed, and now major structural testing of the second prototype. Sales continue strong with more than two years of production already sold and nearly half of these to mission organizations, God has honored our vision and faith!
