The only way into Allison Ranch is by foot, by boat up the white-water of the Salmon River or a one hour flight into the roadless wilderness of north Idaho. With many short, rugged old homestead airstrips in the area, MAF trains here three times a year. No planes bigger than these MAF Cessna 206s, with only very expert pilots, can negotiate this short 900 ft. “one-way” strip with solid rock mountains at both ends. The roaring river is 90 ft. below your only approach, as seen here. Yet our ten seat turbine Kodiak, which carries three times the payload and flies 60 knots faster than these little Cessnas, handles Allison with ease!

Missions continue to join Quest with more and more Kodiak orders. Wally Wiley, MAF manager in Indonesia writes; “We are all very excited that Kodiaks will be coming our way soon... it is harder and harder to continue our ministry with the 206. I am convinced it will have a great impact on God's Kingdom as it supports ministries around the world!” - MAF already has 13 Kodiaks on order.

Kodiak testing continues with increasing confidence that only minor modifications may remain. The FAA approval now looks more and more certain by early fall. This new date has, however, placed our remaining funding need at \$1,000,000. We need to finish this funding by summer and with recent progress we trust we can now hold that date!
